Authorization to Reproduce

There are legal concerns involved in using a photograph and other tangible works, which have a copyright. The reproduction of cards, designs, photographs or other tangible works requires the written consent of the author (i.e. artist, photographer, writer, composer). Ownership or possession of a copy does not give the possessor the right to reproduce the work without written consent of the author.

Most professional photographers do retain automatic copyright privileges on all their work. A customer must have permission from the photographer for the use of a photo or negative with a copyright. When a copyright negative or photo by another party is sent to Photography by Michael Howard, we must have a release form signed by the said party to be able to use the photograph.

The author of the work to be reproduced must complete this form. Please send in the completed Authorization to Reproduce form (with a sample of the copyright item attached) with any order requesting reproduction of a card, design, photograph or other tangible works.
